

Y CHILD WATCH

At the Kalihi YMCA Child Watch serves keiki's ages 3 months to 12 years while parents or guardians are in the facility. Available on a first-come, first-served basis, children may attend the Child Watch Center for a maximum of 2 hours per day, and parents **MUST** remain on the premises.

Please bring your **membership ED** with you and **sign in** so that we know where you can be located in the building. Please bring all supplies to keep you child clean and comfortable. Be prepared for your keiki's needs. Please label all items including bottles, cups, backpacks, snacks, and toys.

Please keep your child home when he/she is sick. If your child is crying or visibly upset while you are gone, staff will comfort, distract, or focus your child on other activities. If your child continues to be upset after 10 minutes, you will be retrieved from your activity in the building. Parents are required to stay on site while your keiki is in Child Watch.

FEES

Child Watch is **FREE** to all family & single parent family memberships up to 2 hours per day. Other YMCA memberships (Adult, Young Adult, Senior, Teen) will pay \$3 per child per hour for use of the Child Watch area. **WE DO NOT ACCEPT PAYMENTS** in the child watch room. Please purchase at the front desk and take receipt to Child Watch room.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Parents must stay in the building while your child is in the child watch
- Sign your child in each visit and list the area where you will be located.
- Staff will sign the child out. Only the parent that signs the child may pick up the child.
- If your child is inconsolable, after 10 minutes you will be asked to return to the child watch room. Please respond immediately.
- Make sure your child has been changed or used the restroom before leaving them in child watch. We do not change diapers at Child Watch. The parent will be notified to come in and change any soiled diapers.
- Share any special needs or stages of your child's development with the staff.
- Sick children will not be accepted in the child watch room.
- If your child contacts a contagious disease and has been in child watch while infectious, please inform staff so that we may notify other parents.
